Sarah P. Farrell Award: Technology Innovation to Remove Barriers

Announcement

The Beta Kappa Chapter of Sigma is now accepting applications for the Inaugural Sarah P. Farrell Award. This award was established to improve the lives of vulnerable populations by addressing health disparities through innovative technology solutions. The \$2,500 Award is granted to <u>one</u> nurse-led team which proposes a technology intervention to address health disparities.

Criteria & Eligibility

- 1. At least one member of the team must be a member in good standing of the Beta Kappa Chapter of Sigma.
- 2. The proposal is for a nurse-led team, not for a single individual's project.
- 3. The scientific merit of the proposed project is intact.
- 4. The technology is innovative.
- 5. Projects must have approval from or have been submitted for determination to appropriate human investigation or IRB committees.

Deadlines and Timelines

- 1. Submit proposal and supporting materials by date in announcement, approximately March each odd-numbered year.
- 2. The decision will be made by the Beta Kappa Board with support from the Beta Kappa Awards Committee, and the recipient is usually announced during Nurses' Week.

Additional Requirements

1. The recipient team must agree to provide a project presentation after the proposed project is complete to selected faculty and to work with a Beta Kappa Member towards further dissemination of outcomes.
