Students are required to enter the correct Plan of Study (POS) into the SIS Planner and review with the academic advisor each semester. Changes to the POS must be approved by the advisor and enrollment in a course outside of the POS is not guaranteed. Note: the term/semester of individual courses is subject to change.

Note: the program director or coordinator conducts a gap analysis for each certificate student at matriculation to assure compliance with national standards requiring that all post-graduate certificate students have educational preparation for the NP role, at least one population focus, and completion of the APRN core courses (NTF Criteria for the Evaluation of NP Program, 2016, III.F).

The certificate student may be required to take GNUR 6020, Advanced Pharmacology, or the specialty specific breakout offered in the Spring.
