## Social Sciences (9 credits)

- AAS courses; **except** AAS literature courses
- AMST Classes (**except** AMST 2300)
- ANTH; **except** some foreign language courses offered as ANTH
- Art History (ARTH)
- ECON (**except** ECON 3710, 3720, 4720)
- All History courses (HIAF, HIEA, HIEU, HIME, HISA, HIST, HIUS)
- Linguistics; 2000-level or above
- Politics; except Political Theory
- PSYC (**except** PSYC 2200, PSYC 3210 and PSYC 4200)
- SOC (**except** SOC 2600)
- WGS (Women, Gender and Sexuality)

## General Education (15 credits)

- Any course will count as a general education elective.
- There is a 3 course (or 7 credit) limit to the number of physical education or skills courses such as studio art or music performance that may be counted toward the elective credit requirement.
