The Beta Kappa President's Scholarship recognizes outstanding academic achievement by student members of Beta Kappa Chapter in good standing who are matriculating at an accredited university nursing program. This scholarship award from the local chapter supports Sigma's global mission to foster excellence, scholarship, and leadership in nursing to improve healthcare. The fund provides \$1,000 academic merit scholarships to individuals for tuition and/or fees incurred through their studies.

Criteria & Eligibility:

- Enrollment in an accredited baccalaureate or graduate program in nursing with a minimum GPA of 3.5
- Active member of Beta Kappa Chapter
- No member of the Awards Committee or the Board of Beta Kappa is eligible for funding while in office or while serving as an Awards Committee member.

Applications will be judged on the quality of their submission and on their potential to contribute to Beta Kappa, nursing, and health care leadership as well as to the greater good of society.

The number of scholarships awarded each year will depend upon the funds available.
